

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Basin Electric North Dakota Power Supply Tour

Physical locations. *Please be aware, GPS or map applications may mislead you. These facilities are adjacent to each other on a well-marked, paved road north of Beulah, ND.*

- Dakota Gasification Company Great Plains Synfuels Plant, 420 County Road 26, Beulah
- Basin Electric Power Cooperative Antelope Valley Station, 294 County Road 15, Beulah (to the north of the Synfuels Plant)
- The Coteau Properties Company Freedom Mine, 204 County Road 15, Beulah (to the north of Antelope Valley)

Buses. If your group is going to the Freedom Mine, make sure your bus company knows the bus will be driving on the mine site. Some companies will not allow off-road travel.

Participation. To be able to fully participate in these tours, tour guests should be able to:

- Wear closed-toe shoes (no flip-flops or high heels).
- Stand for up to 45 minutes.
- Navigate stairs and steel grating without canes, walkers, crutches, walking boots, or any other aide that may be a tripping hazard.
- Withstand temperatures in excess of 100 degrees for up to 10 minutes.
- Ride in bumpy, off-road conditions for up to 90 minutes for coal mine tours.

Tour guests who cannot fully participate will be given opportunities to stay behind in a seating area.

Synfuels Plant visitors must sign the visitor log. For student groups, only the adult chaperones are required to sign in. Tour coordinators, please provide a list of all tour participants.

Field tours at Coteau Freedom Mine are contingent on road conditions on the mine site. If determined by Coteau that road conditions are unsafe for travel into mining areas, an indoor tour will be provided.

Ages. At Antelope Valley Station, children under the age of 6 are not allowed to go out into the plant site. They are however welcome to participate in the model room tour.

At the Freedom Mine, children under the age of 8 must use a car seat or booster seat (to be consistent with state law) if they would like to take a mine tour. There will be no tours for children under 2 years old.
